Meanwhile, Linda brought great expertise and commitment to youth education. Her lessons were so thoughtfully done, and well-prepared. She was willing to go the extra mile. Quality. Always. Linda also served on our first expansion committee, and was instrumental in establishing our goal of raising \$3,000 to create a fund for bringing in credentialed speakers for every Sunday morning. Often the speakers came from Milwaukee or Chicago, and often they stayed at the Bjella home. That's dedication, too!
